Section 212-a of the New York Labor Law requires that any person who for a fee hires, recruits, transports or supplies farm or food processing workers for employers in New York State must register with the New York State Commissioner of Labor and obtain a Certificate of Registration before he/she can engage in such activity.

This office is authorized to issue such certificates and under the law may refuse to issue if it is determined that the applicant has a criminal record which warrants such action. We have received an application for Certificate of Registration from the above person.
