Section 213 of the New York State Labor Law says that any person who violates the New York State Labor Law or regulations and orders of the Commissioner of Labor may be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to civil penalties.

- The penalty for the first offense is a fine up to \$100 and/or up to fifteen days in jail;
- The penalty for the second offense is a fine of \$100 to \$500 and/or up to 30 days in jail;
- The penalty for a subsequent offense is a fine of not less than \$300 and/or up to 60 days in jail.

Section 909 of the New York State Labor Law:

- The penalty for violating Section 902 is up to \$2,500 for the first violation and up to \$4,000 for additional violations.
- The penalty for violating Section 909 is 25% of the monetary value of the contract or \$5,000 for each violation, whichever is greater.
- If you had a prior civil penalty, the civil penalty is 50% of the monetary value of the contract or \$25,000 for each violation, whichever is greater. Each day a violation exists may be a separate violation.
- Your asbestos handling license can be taken away if:
 - The violation(s) are within 3 years of the last civil penalty against you under this article.
 - You committed serious violations of other state, federal or local laws concerning asbestos projects.
 - You have not acted responsibly in jobs removing or handling asbestos.

Section 908 states the contractor must send written notification that the violations are corrected.
