Further Enforcement Action

If you do not pay the remaining balance within 10 days of the date of this letter, we will issue a Notice of Violation. After a formal administrative hearing, you could be charged a civil penalty of up to \$5000.00 or 25% of the monetary value of the contract for the project, whichever is greater, for each violation. The DOL may also ask for your asbestos handling license to be denied or revoked.
